PROPOSED TAX RATE
AUGUST 27, 2012

The Board of Trustees of Burton Independent School District held a public meeting to discuss the budget and proposed tax rate and then vote to adopt the budget and tax rate on Monday, August 27, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. in the Burton High School cafeteria.

The following business was transacted:

1. The meeting was called to order by President Terri Smith. A prayer was given by Marcus Broesche, and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Sam Gibson.
2. The 2012-2013 budget and proposed tax rate were discussed.
3. A motion was made by Mrs. Harmel and seconded by Mr. Gibson to adopt the 2012-2013 budget as presented. Motion passed unanimously. The adopted budget is \$4,577,911.00.
4. A motion was made by Mr. Gibson and seconded by Mrs. Lucherk to adopt an ordinance setting the tax rate at \$1.1700 per \$100.00 valuation. The ad valorem tax rate will be distributed as follows: \$1.0400 for maintenance and operation and \$.1300 for interest and sinking. Motion passed unanimously.
5. A motion was made by Mr. Gibson and seconded by Mr. Broesche to approve the budget amendments for 2011-2012 as presented. Motion passed unanimously. (Copy attached.)
6. A motion was made by Mr. Gibson and seconded by Mr. Broesche to adjourn at 6:45 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
